On Board Cruise Safety

1. Have a family meeting about ship safety in your cabin.
2. Children should learn their cabin number and location. It's a good idea for them to know the name of their cabin steward.
3. Locate your life jackets in your stateroom.
4. Attend the muster drill.
5. Tell your children to NEVER run onboard ship.
6. Children should always wear sneakers, water shoes, no flip flops. Small children can get their flip flops caught in the treads of automatic doors.
7. NEVER let children go to the pool UNATTENDED without an adult.
8. When walking around the ship do not let children walk near railings in common spaces or outside decks.
9. Children and adults should NEVER lean or peer over railings they could lose their footing, slip and fall.
10. Locate the customer service desk as a family. If a child gets lost or needs help they can get assistance at the customer service desk.
11. Tell children NEVER to play in or around an elevator.
